

### Recycling Info:

Although there is no longer a curbside pickup service provided by the county, there is still a free recycling program in Lake County! There are numerous close-by locations that you can drop off your recyclables. Here is a list of locations and what you are able to recycle:

You may recycle:

Newspapers and magazines

Chipboard- ie. Cereal boxes, cookie/cracker boxes, detergent boxes, etc

Corrugated cardboard- moving boxes, etc.

Glass- clear, green, brown, food and beverage containers only

Aluminum & metal cans -includes trays, empty aerosol cans, metal cookware

Plastic- all plastic food containers as well as other containers with a 1 or 2 on them
